It was proposed and agreed at the Parish Council meeting of 5th May 2022 (minute ref. 9a) that Bradpole Parish Council proceed with the purchase of outdoor fitness equipment for Gore Cross Recreation Ground. The cost to purchase the fitness equipment from Sunshine Gym was confirmed as £8,614 plus VAT. In addition, it was confirmed that a CIL payment of £3,416.30 (CIL/WD/19/48) had unexpectedly been received by the parish relating to an October 2018 planning decision. It was proposed and agreed that the CIL total of £3,416.30 be used as part payment towards the purchase of the fitness equipment with the remaining amount being paid from allocated council reserves and donations from local businesses.
