BANP monitoring working group recommendations to Bradpole Parish Council.

As a group we agreed on the following recommendations to the Parish Council for consideration and agreement...

We propose our continued support for the Plan, as long as the following points are met:

- The timeline should be made firm, including a clear and focused remit established at the inception meeting for the whole process to be brought to completion by March 2019.
- The budget should continue to be managed sufficiently so that we as a council are not required to make any further payments.
- Parishes should be given reasonable opportunity to be represented at key stages of the process, including at the inception meeting.

We also propose that our current level of involvement is maintained, namely that we do not sit on the Steering Group but continue to be represented by Cllr Baker on the Joint Council. This is because we wish to remain involved, although the Steering Group are largely complete in their role now and it should be left to the consultants to bring the project to completion without any further “steering”.

Our group met on Tuesday 23rd January 2018 and Cllr Baker attended the Joint Council meeting on Thursday 25th. Subsequent to this he has emailed us with further updates, which suggest that our conditional points are being met to an acceptable level and therefore our proposal of continued support on the basis outlined above should be maintained.
