## Neighbourhood Plan

After 5 years of development by local volunteers the Bridport Area Neighbourhood Plan (BANP) has been submitted to Dorset Council which is undertaking a public consultation as the next stage.

An adopted Plan will sit alongside the Local Plan setting out the development criteria for the wider Bridport area including Bradpole Civil Parish. It also provides an opportunity to designate Green spaces for additional protection to that afforded by the Area of Outstanding Beauty (AONB) status that covers the whole of the wider Bridport Area.
